As of yesterday's report, Greenwood County had no additional confirmed case in the county for a total of 10 cases confirmed since 21 March.. *Remember this is only those which have been confirmed and is for those who were tested a minimum of two days ago. This means there are others who have been tested and are in quarantine awaiting results. Additionally, an individual can be asymptomatic, (contagious but shows no symptoms), who would not meet the criteria to be tested.*

The first three cases in Greenwood County were reported over 15 days ago, so there are 3 individuals who should have recovered from the virus. This brings Greenwood County's remaining total of active confirmed cases to 7. *DHEC does not track recovered individuals, so this number is an estimate based on the following: Most individuals recover from the virus within this time frame; no deaths have been reported for Greenwood County.*

SCDHEC reported an additional 132 cases in 46 counties for a total of 2049. Also, they reported 4 new deaths in five counties for a total of 44; Clarendon, Horry, Beaufort, and Lee. 2 individuals were elderly with underlying health issues and one was middle age with underlying health issues. The 4th was elderly and DHEC is still investigating if there were underlying health issues. .

As of 5 April 2020, SCDHEC and private labs have tested 18,976 individuals. Of this number, 2049 have tested positive and 16,927 have tested negative across the state.
